

MAKE A TOILET ROLL BIRD FEEDER

Would you like to bring beautiful birds to your back garden, balcony or window box? Use simple household items to attract your local feathered friends. How many can you spot?

You will need:

A toilet roll, kitchen roll or any other cardboard tube.

Peanut butter (no added salt and sugar versions)

Bird seed

A plate and some string

Optional extra: a twig



Instructions:

1. Spread the peanut butter over the outside of your cardboard tube. Make sure it's a nice thick layer.

2. Sprinkle your bird seed onto the plate and roll the tube over it, making sure the peanut butter is well covered.

3. Take a piece of string and feed it through your tube and tie in a secure knot to make a loop. If you would like to add a perch, ask an adult to pierce two holes on opposite sides of the tube so you can slot the stick through it, creating a perch on either side.

4. Tie it up in a spot in your garden, or on your balcony, where birds will feel safe eating.
